The Australasian Association of Clinical Geneticists (AACG) Professional Issues Committee (PIC) is seeking expressions of interest for new committee members.

Committee

The AACG PIC is a sub-committee of the AACG Special Interest Group of the Human Genetics Society of Australasia (HGSA). The aims of the AACG PIC are to:

- Identify, assess, and prioritise the current professional issues facing clinical geneticists in Australia and New Zealand.
- Represent the interests of clinical geneticists in advancing solutions to these issues.
- Actively identify new and emerging professional issues over time.

Membership

Committee members must:

- be current members of the HGSA, and ideally (but not necessarily) AACG members
- hold Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians (FRACP) in Clinical Genetics and have been awarded FHGSA by the HGSA (excepting Trainee members)

Commitment

- Committee members will stand for a term of two years.
- At a minimum, the full Committee will meet at least quarterly.
- Each committee member will sit on at least one of the committee workstreams that will meet as needed to progress their objectives. Current workstreams are:
 - Workforce Data
 - Education and Training
 - Funding Models
 - Mainstreaming
 - Technology

Committee members will be selected by the AACG PIC Executive on behalf of the AACG and the HGSA Board of Directors. We particularly encourage applications from individuals who work in private practice, in order to represent the interests of this group.
